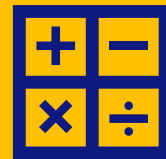

Online Maths Resources - New section on our school website

As part of the current cycle of school self evaluation, we have been looking at ways to improve maths in our school. Our staff, led by Ms. Hegarty, have been engaging in much discussion and collaboration about our current practices and seeking to find ways to fine tune things. The hope is that this process will smoothly facilitate any changes coming with the introduction of the new primary maths curriculum which is being introduced from September 2024.

One area which was identified following our parental surveys last year was guidance on what topics your children will be covering in the various classes. Here you will be able to access documents for Rang 3 to Rang 6 outlining the various maths strands and what your child will be learning about in each particular year.
