Child Safeguarding and Risk Assessment Review

The Board of Management of Holy Cross School would like to inform all parents and members of the Holy Cross School community that the annual review of the school's Child Safeguarding Statement was completed at the most recent Board of Management meeting. The review was conducted in accordance with the Checklist for Review of the Child Safeguarding Statement published on the Department of Education website – gov.ie.

Our updated Child Safeguarding Policy can be viewed on our school's website - www.holycrossschool.ie - in the "Policies" section under the "Information for Parents" tab.

The Designated Liaison Person (DLP) in Holy Cross School is the Principal, John McGrath. The DLP acts as contact in the case of Child Protection concerns you may have about your child or another child in the school. In his absence please contact the Deputy Designated Liaison Person (DDLP), Mr. Eoin Fitzgerald.

The Board of Management would also like to inform you that new Child Protection Procedures have been released by the Department of Education. Following staff and BOM training, we will be updating our Child Safeguarding Procedures to reflect these changes.
