For any parents coming to the school who may be unfamiliar with the layout or where the classrooms are, we will have everything well signposted for you!

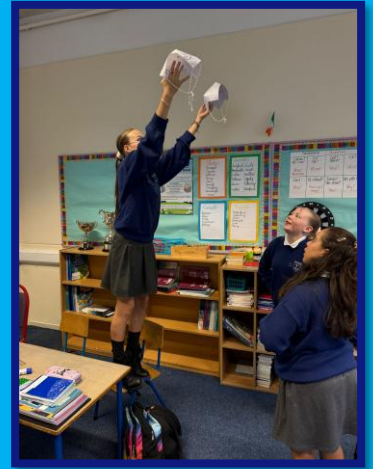
