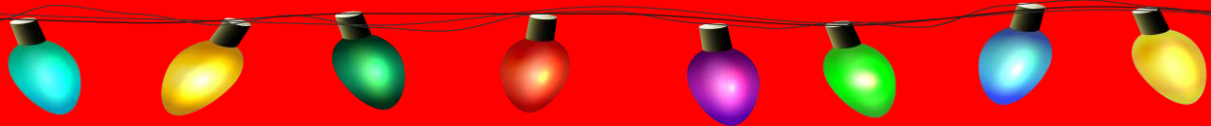

Nasal Flu Vaccinations

This Thursday, 27th November, the HSE team will be providing nasal flu vaccinations to children in Holy Cross. The vaccine will only be administered to children who returned a completed form granting consent. There are no special requirements on the day other than ensuring your child eats a good breakfast.

Please contact the vaccination team before Thursday if

- Your child has had influenza anti-viral medications in the 48hours before receiving the vaccine.
- Your child has an acute exacerbation of asthma in the previous 72hours before vaccination.
- Your child has received a dose of the flu vaccine since the consent form was returned to the school.
- Your child is unwell with a sudden fever as vaccination should be delayed until recovery.
