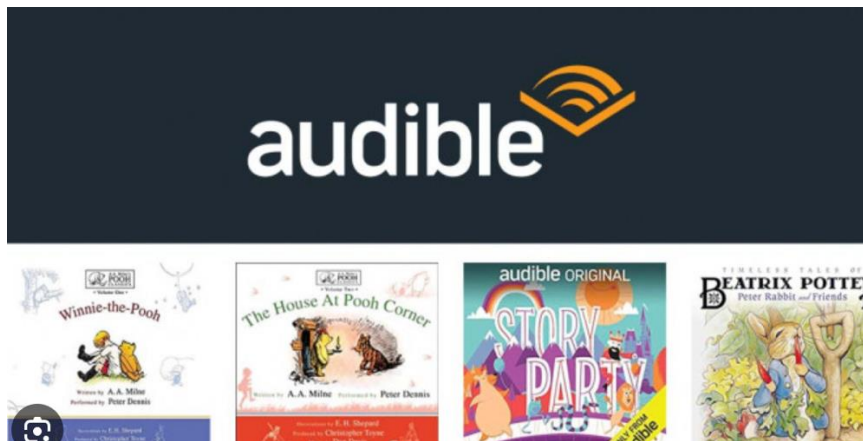


## Literacy Resources

Audio books are great for long car journeys. Kids love listening to the likes of David Walliams read his funny stories (which can be quite entertaining for adults too!)

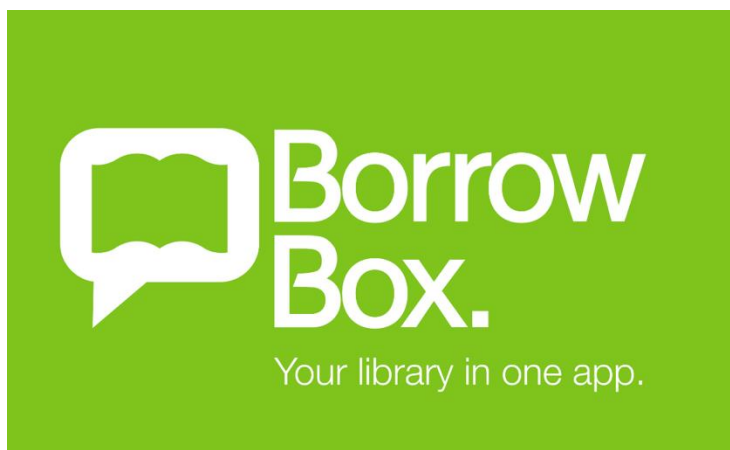
